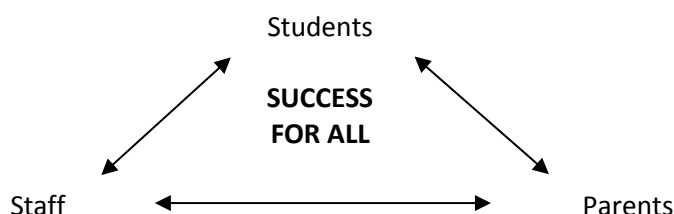

5. Keeping Parents informed and involved in their child's education

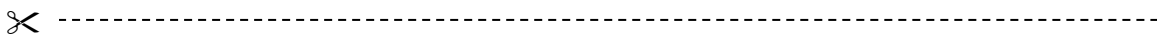
As a Parent I commit myself to:
