Dear Parent/ Carer,

Re: Staggered Re-Opening of the Academy from Monday 4 January 2021

As many of you will be aware from announcements in the press yesterday, the government is introducing a gradual re-opening of secondary schools after the Christmas Break to support the introduction of a new 'rapid test' programme in schools. The practical implications of this are therefore as follows:

Monday 4 January 2021

Year 11 students ONLY will return to the Academy for a normal Academy Day.

Year 7, 8, 9 and 10 students will work from home receiving their work on MS Teams until Friday 8 January.

Students classified as 'vulnerable' or as the children of key workers will also be able to return to school on 4 January 2021. Where one parent/ carer is at home a child should remain at home even if both parents/ carers are classified as 'key workers'. Any such attendance must be agreed in advance by contacting the Vice Principal directly on rellis@lanfranc.org.uk

This will be Week B.

Monday 11 January 2021

ALL students will return to the Academy and resume their normal timetable. This will be Week A.

My sincere apologies for this last minute change to the term programme and any inconvenience this may cause which as I'm sure you will appreciate is beyond our control.
