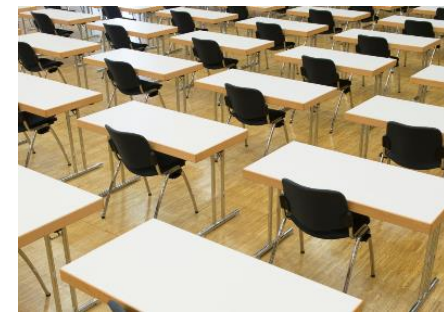

- Complete the exam to the best of your ability!

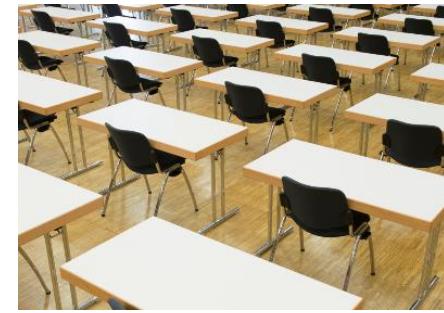
## End of Exams
